- The people you may visit will be receiving care, are vulnerable and often have communication difficulties for many reasons such as dementia, learning disabilities or difficulties following a stroke or other physical conditions
- You will try to understand the person you are supporting and encourage everyone involved in their care and support to see the "whole person"
- This is a brilliant opportunity to support someone in your local area

She now lives in a residential home; she is frail and finds it difficult to be understood. June needs support from someone who can still see the person who laughed, danced, loved and cried.
